Recruiting Budget Committee Member

The City of Westfir is recruiting to fill one vacancy on the Budget Committee by March 2, 2020. The Budget Committee is a standing committee that reviews the proposed operating and capital budget each fiscal year and makes a recommendation on the budget to the City Council for final adoption.

The Budget Committee is composed of an equal number of City Officials (5) and appointed citizen members (5). The term is three years.

To be eligible, the applicant must:

- 1. Live in the City for one year prior to application;
- 2. Live and be registered to vote in the City; and
- 3. Not be an officer, agent or employee of the City.

To apply, please submit a letter of interest including qualifications and a signed statement that the applicant is willing to serve as a member of the budget committee for a term of three years and to adhere to the policies of the City. The Budget Committee will be holding meetings in April, May and June if need be.

Do you need a Real ID?

On October 1, 2020 the TSA will begin requiring a new kind of ID to board airplanes. The new ID must be compliant with something called the Real ID Act, and the current Oregon driver license is not Real ID compliant.

Oregon DMV will begin offering a Real ID option on July 6, 2020, but with nearly one million Oregonians who will want the Real ID, the DMV can't fulfill all the demand by October 1.

Another option is to obtain a passport card. The cost of getting a new passport card is roughly equal to that of getting a replacement license with the Real ID option—and you can apply now at one of over 76 acceptance sites across Oregon.
